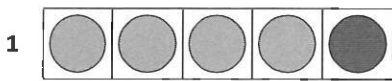


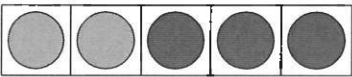

## Page 1



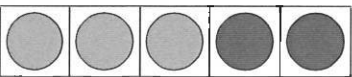
4 and 1 makes 5

$$\boxed{4} + \boxed{1} = \boxed{5}$$



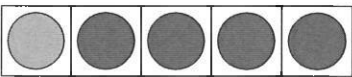
2 and 3 makes 5

3 and 2 makes 5

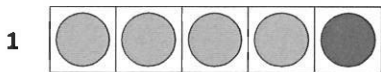
$$\boxed{3} + \boxed{2} = \boxed{5}$$



1 and 4 makes 5

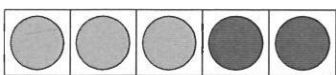
$$\boxed{1} + \boxed{4} = \boxed{5}$$

$$5 - \boxed{1} = \boxed{4}$$



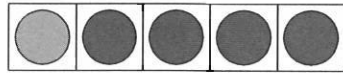
5 take away 2 leaves 3

$$5 - \boxed{3} = \boxed{2}$$



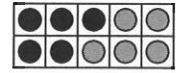
5 take away 4 leaves 1

$$5 - \boxed{4} = \boxed{1}$$



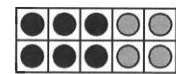
4 and 6 is 10

$$\boxed{4} + \boxed{6} = \boxed{10}$$



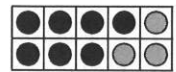
5 and 5 is 10

$$\boxed{5} + \boxed{5} = \boxed{10}$$



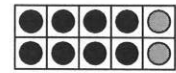
6 and 4 is 10




